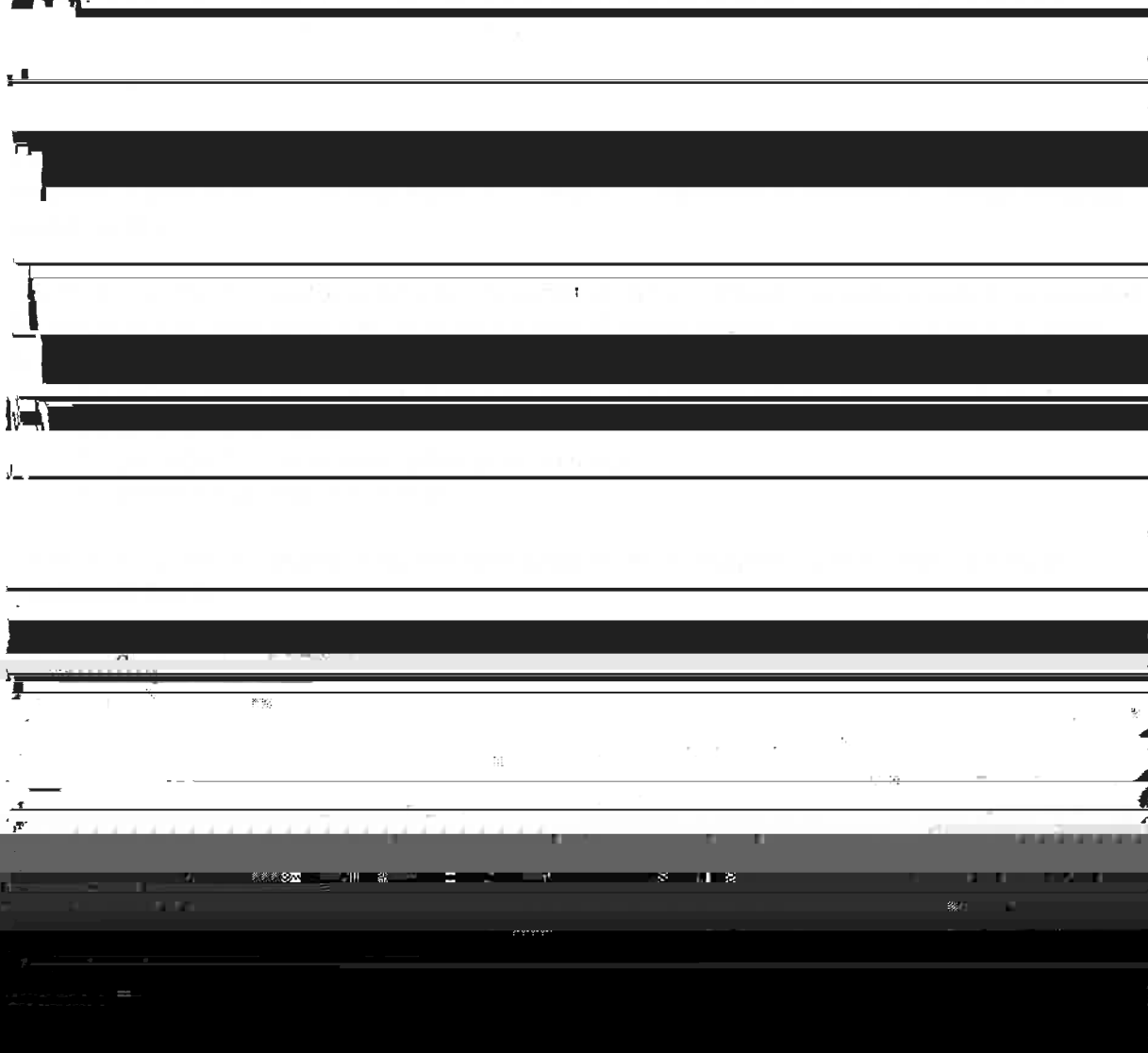

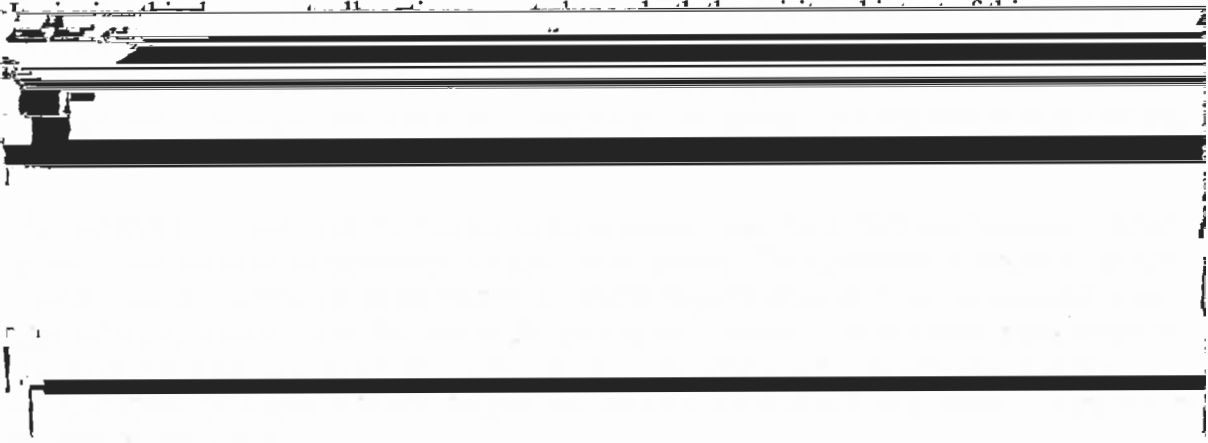

WCC students who earn an associate's degree in dental hygiene with a minimum 2.5 cumulative grade point average, and who have a current dental hygiene license, will be eligible to matriculate to the WSU academic program in place for that catalog year. The RDH to BSDH degree completion program at WSU is completely online and accessible 24 hours a day. It can be completed in as little as 15 months full-time or up to six years of part-time study.
